Key Topics Required For Exam:
LO1: Understand the Environment in which hospitality and Catering provision operates: Commercial/non-commercial sectors, job requirements LO2: Understand how Hospitality and Catering provision operates: operations of the kitchen: equipment used/stock control. How HCI meets customer requirements with the services they offer. LO3: Understand how hospitality and Catering provision meets health and safety requirements: responsibility of employers for employees safety. LO4: Know how food can cause ill health: Roles of the environmental health officer, common types/symptoms of food poisoning, symptoms of allergic reactions.
Useful Revision Strategies:
<p>The exam lasts 1 1/2 hours and all questions are compulsory.</p> <p>Questions are marked according to the quantity and quality of the answer you should provide i.e. a 1 mark question requires 1 answer, 4 marks or more should be answered in the style of an essay with 4+ valuable comments.</p> <p>The paper will contain short-answer, structured and free response question</p> <p>EXAM PAPERS The types of question used...</p> <p>1. Complete the flowchart or Tables Mainly one or two word answers, written in the appropriate boxes. Marks will be awarded for each correctly identified step plus a mark for getting them all in the right order.</p> <p>2. Evaluate Normally one or two sentences where the quality, suitability or value of something is judged. This can include both positive and negative points, with each point normally requiring a relevant justification, reason or example.</p> <p>3. Give / State Normally a one or two word answer, at the very most a short sentence. e.g. Job Roles. Should be an accurate and clear list.</p>

4. Name / Name the Specific

As above, but requires specific detail to be given e.g. equipment names. Generic answers will gain no marks.

5. Describe

Identify distinctive features: give a description and factual details. No explanations are needed for just 'describe' unless the word states 'describe and explain'

6. Recommend:

Put forward or suggest an answer than is suitable for the question

7. Justify

Review to give reasons why you think something is better than something else and support this with evidence.
