









A580/A570 - WINDLE ISLAND JUNCTION IMPROVEMENTS Balfour Beatty

Dear Resident / Business Owner

We would like to inform you about works which will be taking place from 7th October for around 4 weeks. Mainly during normal working hours with a week of nights. The works are a combination of finishing works to footpaths, dealing with ponding issues and additional works instructed by the Council to further improve the junction.

There will be full time lane closures on the A580 East Lancs and A570 Rainford bypass, with a 30mph speed restriction.

2-way lights will be installed on Moss Lane, Rainford Rd and Crank Rd for a period, during the 4 weeks.

Access to properties and businesses will be maintained at all times and businesses will be open as usual. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times via the permanent crossing route; however a diversion of the existing pathway if needed will be in place.

The work is subject to weather conditions, particularly sensitive due to traffic management installation. We advise drivers to take alternative routes where possible and allowing additional time for their journey.
