10. How many contour lines would you see on a map of flat ground?

11. What would the 6-figure grid reference be of somewhere right in the middle of grid square (42,32)?

12. What would the compass direction be of a point that was in between north-east and east?

13. When measuring straight line distance, where on the scale line should your first point be placed?
