# <u>Subject Overview (coursework/exam split, timings, weightings etc.):</u>

#### Paper 1: Listening- Understanding and responding to different types of spoken language (25%):

- •Written exam: 35 minutes (Foundation Tier), 45 minutes (Higher Tier)
- •40 marks (Foundation Tier), 50 marks (Higher Tier)

(Each exam includes 5 minutes' reading time of the question paper before the listening stimulus is played.)

### Questions (Foundation & Higher Tier)

Section A- questions in English, to be answered in English or non-verbally

Section B - questions in French /Spanish, to be answered in French/Spanish or non-verbally

<u>Paper 2: Speaking- Communicating/ interacting effectively in speech for a variety of purposes</u> (Non-exam assessment) – 25% of GCSE:

- •7–9 minutes (Foundation Tier) + preparation time
- •10–12 minutes (Higher Tier) + preparation time
- •60 marks (for each of Foundation Tier and Higher Tier)

Questions - Role-play – 15 marks (2 minutes), Photo card – 15 marks (2 minutes) and General conversation – 30 marks (3–5 minutes at Foundation Tier; 5–7 minutes at Higher Tier)

## Paper 3: Reading- Understanding and responding to different types of written language (25%)

- Written exam: 45 minutes (Foundation Tier), 1 hour (Higher Tier)
- •60 marks (for each of Foundation Tier and Higher Tier)

Questions (Foundation Tier and Higher Tier)

Section A – questions in English, to be answered in English or non-verbally

Section B – questions in French /Spanish, to be answered in French /Spanish or non-verbally

Section C – translation from French /Spanish into English

#### Paper 4: Writing: Communicating effectively in writing for a variety of purposes (25%)

- •Written exam: 1 hour (Foundation Tier), 1 hour 15 minutes (Higher Tier)
- •50 marks at Foundation Tier and 60 marks at Higher Tier

## **Foundation Tier**

- •Question 1 message (student produces four sentences) 8 marks
- $\cdot$  Question 2 short passage (student writes a piece of text in response to four bullet points, approximately 40 words in total) 16 marks
- Question 3 translation from English into French /Spanish (minimum 35 words) 10 marks
- •Question 4 structured writing task (student responds to four compulsory detailed bullet points, producing approximately 90 words in total) there is a choice from two questions 16 marks

#### **Higher Tier**

- •Question 1 structured writing task (student responds to four compulsory detailed bullet points, producing approximately 90 words in total) there is a choice from two questions 16 marks
- •Question 2 open-ended writing task (student responds to two compulsory detailed bullet points, producing approximately 150 words in total) there is a choice from two questions 32 marks
- Question 3 translation from English into French /Spanish (minimum 50 words) 12 marks

How do I revise single words?

#### Quizlet

- Search for RainfordMFL (remember to select 'Users' when searching!)
- Flashcards click on the sound button to hear the word. Click the card to flip it over and check that your child's translation is correct!
- Create your own study sets to practise the words that you are struggling with. Add pictures!
- Use the games 'Match' and 'Gravity' to help you practise the vocabulary.

### Seneca

- Complete 10% of the GCSE course vocabulary each half term.
- Encourage your child to do Seneca when they are on their computer/phone/tablet
- Check your child is using the programme properly not looking at screenshots of the words!

## Flashcards

- Look at the words you need to memorise. Filter out the words that are easy to remember.
- Make flashcards for the words you think you'll struggle remembering. Write the word in Spanish on one side and the word in English on the other side.
- Look at your flashcards a few times. Shuffle the cards and do it again a couple of times.
- Now, try to look at the English words and say or write the words in Spanish/French.



- Shuffle the cards and do it again a couple of times. Put the cards that you know very well aside.
- Concentrate on the cards that you find harder. Repeat!

How do I revise useful phrases or chunks of text?

- Use a whiteboard to write out the sentence. Your child should read the sentence a few times, then you should cover some words in the text and see if they can still read it correctly.
- Write the first letter of the each word and see if you can fill in the sentence.
- Use memorizer.me to practise this online.
