


## Information for candidates

Written examinations

With effect from 1 September 2021

At Rainford, we define malpractice as ‘Any action by the student that has the potential to undermine the integrity and validity of the assessment of the student’s work’, and we would ask all students to be aware of the implications of malpractice prior to the examination season.
