# CURRICULUM

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At Rainford High we are developing a curriculum that supports, stretches and challenges our students from Year 7 – and in many cases, before they arrive through our supportive transition process – until they leave. We work hard to ensure our students experience strong foundations of traditional ‘core’ subjects complemented by foundation subjects and enrichment opportunities to provide a strong platform for future success and rewarding experiences in school.

Students are taught in broad ability groups to support their learning and progress in Year 7, 8 and 9 before following an adapted curriculum in Year 10 and 11 in preparation for their GCSE examinations. These mixed prior attainment groups at Key Stage 3 ensure that students are appropriately challenged, engaged and supported across the curriculum. Our assessment system ensures that students’ learning is regularly tested and parents and students receive accurate and timely information about progress.

We believe every student must be motivated and enthused through the best quality teaching we can offer, and our teachers plan lessons designed to build on the knowledge, skills and understanding students will need to demonstrate in making excellent progress.





# STUDENT SUPPORT & WELFARE

**Rainford High is committed to the highest standards of behaviour and personal well being of all our students**



We do our utmost to make sure that every student is well known and cared for through our Student Support System. Your child will be allocated to a Tutor Group, led by a Learning Tutor, who will support your child daily and they will be your child's first port of call for any concerns. They will see your child each morning and support them in making a positive start to each day. They will develop their personal, social and health skills and encourage excellent attendance, behaviour and progress. Through tradition, each student is allocated to one of five houses: Resilience, Integrity, Compassion, Endeavour and Determination.

Each year group has a Learning Leader, who oversees the year group and supports each student in achieving their potential, and a Pastoral Leader who supports with issues such as welfare concerns, behaviour, attendance - anything that may be a barrier to your child's success. The Student Support Team work closely with our parents/carers and Learning Support to provide the appropriate package needed to help your child achieve their potential. We believe encouragement and positive praise are essential to students being happy in their learning and school experience. Our school engagement scores and house points - designed to reward consistent standards of commitment - and merits and electronic post cards are just some of the ways we will recognise the excellent work of your child. We have a strong school ethos that underlines our high expectations of behaviour, attendance and presentation and we will always challenge and support students that fall below our high expectations.

Positive behaviour and standards are expected, recognised and rewarded. We work together with parents/carers to help provide appropriate support to help students make positive choices in the future:

## SEND Learning Support

The trustees, governors and staff are committed to the inclusion of all students with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities in the full life of the school, with equal access to a broad and balanced curriculum. We always aim to raise the aspirations and expectations for all students, including anyone identified with Special Educational Needs.

Because Everyone Matters at Rainford, the support for students with SEN/D is a core principle as we strive to break down barriers – educationally, socially and emotionally. This underpins our teaching and learning, regardless of particular needs or abilities. Every child, whatever their difficulties, is supported in finding strategies to deal with and overcome any challenges in their school life. At Rainford we have a number of different interventions and provisions to support students' differing needs.

## Mental Health and Wellbeing

At Rainford High, we believe in promoting positive mental health and emotional wellbeing. Prioritising the wellbeing of students and staff ensures that outstanding teaching and learning can take place, and that the school is a community where everyone feels able to thrive.





# STUDENT CONDUCT AND PRESENTATION

## As a school we value honesty, integrity and hard work

We believe that a disciplined and ordered working environment with high expectations encourages students to develop the self-discipline which is essential if they are to lead productive and happy lives.

To this end, emphasis is placed on a positive code of conduct, on high standards of personal presentation and on identifying qualities and values to which students should aspire. Good behaviour is expected, recognised and rewarded.

Parents can be assured that when students occasionally fall below the standards expected they will be corrected, and where necessary, sanctions will be issued.

Parents are always fully informed and it is expected that they will give strong support to the school in its efforts to eradicate misconduct and maintain the high standards necessary for an effective learning environment.

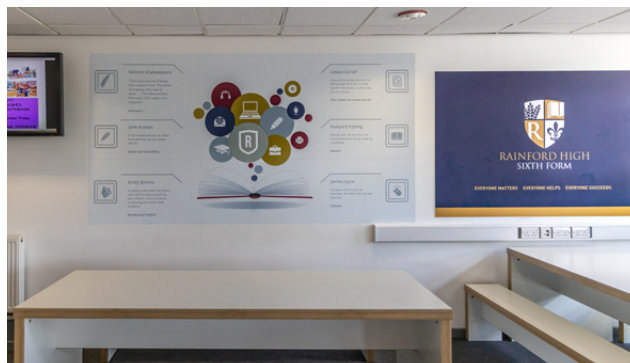

This modern and purpose built Sixth Form provides for approximately 300 students: large enough to facilitate a broad range of subjects and experiences, yet still ensuring all our students are known as individuals and are supported personally. As a close-knit Sixth Form, we have a strong focus on supporting our students to achieve not only their desired qualifications, but their ambitions for the future as well.
